2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This is the 10th consecutive year that the Ogemaw Hills Snowmobile Club (OHSC) is offering a \$500 Scholarship to one graduating senior from West Branch-Rose City Area Schools. This year the Club is accepting applications from Hale Area Schools and Whittemore-Prescott Area Schools.

Applicants must have an interest in snowmobiling as a recreational activity and have plans to further their education in an accredited university, state college, technical or trade school.

Scholarships will be given to the winner regardless of other grants or scholarships that the student may also receive.

REQUIREMENTS:

PART I:

- 1. GPA of 2.0 or "C" average
- 2. Photo of your snowmobile if you have one, preferably with you in the photo.
- 3. Photo of You. (Preferably Your Senior Picture)
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a School Administrator, Teacher, Counselor, Coach, or Employer. Only one letter is required, NOT all four.
- 5. Be available for a scholarship presentation the snowmobile clubhouse located at 2846 N. Fairview Rd. West Branch, MI 48661

Note: The OHSC Scholarship Award will be in the form of a check sent directly to your school of choice with your student account number for the Fall term. You must be able to provide your Student Number.

*Non-attendance at the program will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
